
2023-2033 Pennsylvania Cancer Control Plan ——Report Card ——

The 2023-2033 Pennsylvania Cancer Control Plan guides statewide efforts for ten years to ensure that resources from state, federal, and other sources are focused on cancer control priorities and evidence-based interventions to make the greatest impact on Pennsylvania's cancer burden.



The Cancer Plan was developed by a broad stakeholder group working in all aspects of cancer control, with guidance from The Pennsylvania Comprehensive Cancer Control Program (PCC) and the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH). This 2023-2033 Cancer Plan Goals Report Card was created by the PCC's evaluation partner: the Research and Evaluation group at Public Health Management Corporation (PHMC). 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
