	<ul> <li>view identified things for Heather, Mark, April to follow up with:</li> <li>Check how "leadership" is defined by the 9 habits and ensure this is clear when "leadership" is mentioned in the survey.</li> <li>Habit 3 uses the word "alliance": review how this appears in the original habits and review for appropriateness with the PCC</li> <li>Habit 5 is about both fiscal and non-financial resources: the subcommittee identified a need for the small group to workshop an additional question about the need to assess and plan resource use.</li> <li>Review the idea of whether it's appropriate to use "sustainable," for the workgroup/subcommittee action plan activities (do they always need sustaining or are one-time or stepwise?)</li> </ul>
