1	<p><b>Welcome &amp; Opening</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Call theme today –“Catch Up Now”</li> <li>• Need for urgency for HPV catch up program now before COVID-19 vax reaches adolescents due to the blackout period surrounding the COVID-19 vax.</li> <li>• Janine Owens joining as a new member Chief Education Officer &amp; Department EVP for PA Academy of Family Physicians (PAFP)</li> <li>• Tracy Frank, Cancer Screening Manager from Adagio Health</li> <li>• Tatyana Abreur Cancer Screening Navigator form Adagio Health in Erie</li> </ul>
2	<p><b>Member Spotlight Sharing</b> <b>Heather Entenmann from Merck &amp; Dr. Parkerson (Merck)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Impact of COVID on recovery of routine immunizations and decline in adolescent coverage rates due to sharp decline in wellness visits</li> <li>• Good rebound for babies to get routine immunizations</li> <li>• 30-35% in adolescent recovery for wellness visits</li> <li>• CDC stated that there are approx. 9 million missing doses of vaccines in the Medicaid/uninsured children/adolescents. Discrepancy between public and private insurance</li> <li>• COVID-19 vaccine requires no concomitant vax administration for a 8-9 week blackout period in 12-15yo</li> <li>• Need to do push for “back to school” season in early spring before COVID-19 vax is available for 12-15yo</li> <li>• Dr. Nicole Parkerson – parents aren’t understanding urgency. Providers are uncertain what to prioritize (MenB being interrupted) and don’t want to miss opportunity for COVID. Data for impact on cancer for the next 10 years from missing these kids.</li> <li>• Working with DOH and VFC leaders to promote outreach, education and awareness.</li> </ul>

4	<p><b>Open Member Sharing</b></p> <p><b>Lyn Robertson</b> – Chair on PAIC.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Providing funds for radio announcements in regards to vaxes. Currently have billboards and bus ads promoting vaccines. Will present issue to board as a potential focus of PAIC</li> </ul> <p><b>Erin Moskel</b> – how can we put out messaging through pharmacists and dentists?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PCOH (Helen Hawkey) has been putting HPV flyers in dental offices but has been receiving a lot of pushback. Encouraging them to focus only on oral cancer and call it an “oral cancer vaccine.” Struggling with vaccine hesitancy and resistance with dental providers and social media.</li> </ul> <p><b>Brenda A. DOH</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Christina Reardon (<a href="mailto:ccreardon@temple.edu">ccreardon@temple.edu</a>) is looking for some assistance reviewing some curriculum she is developing for dental providers. Lyn Robertson is volunteering to help. Jill McCullough-Squire volunteered as well..</li> <li>• <b>Evelyn Gonzalez</b> – urges reviewers to focus on health disparities and the racial and ethnic burden</li> </ul> <p><b>William Calo – PSCOM</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clinicians at PSH are already struggling with communicating with parents of their 16 yo patients.</li> <li>• Blackout period is only while the vaccines are considered EUA. Once FDA approved they’ll be able to be give concomitant vaccines</li> </ul> <p><b>JonEtta Depp</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Problems with 12-15yo vaxes – vaxes given in community centers and that info isn’t communicated to the PCPs</li> <li>• Pharmacies are not required to put in PA SIIS for adults at least</li> </ul>
