5. Old Business by Pam Schauer—

Dental HPV Toolkit has been branded and is ready to go! Housed with PA Coalition of Oral Health (PCOH) and is now live <https://paoralhealth.org/requestmaterials/>

There are funds available to get printed materials. Survey is ready and now going with toolkits. They have been attending conferences to disseminate toolkit by sending to dentists and oral hygienists, 4 so far in May

6. New Business & Resource Sharing by William Calo —

Mana Mozaffarian – CMS is now reimbursing stand-alone vaccine counseling for vaccination among adolescent populations. Mana is checking to see if dental providers are also able to claim this reimbursement. Medicaid Coverage of Stand-alone Vaccine Counseling:
