**Dr. Nicole Parkerson** – Shared some Merck data charts on vaccination. Providers are busy with sick and mental health visits, but teenagers are not coming in for their vaccination appointments. Studies suggest it's going to take a minimum of 3-7 years to catch up to where we were at baseline pre-pandemic. Pediatricians are being urged to promote the COVID-19 vaccine among 5-11 years, potentially competing with their ability to promote the HPV vaccination. Nikole will share data with workgroup

**William Calo** – Personal experience is that local clinics are short staffed and are unable to offer things like flu shot clinics to promote vaccination.

**Kayla Knock** – PA AAP is concerned about low purchasing orders for PA immunizations. Any reminder/recall interventions that can be used in schools to help with promoting vaccination?
