4	Donna shared that the Biomarker bill (HB 1754) passed unanimously out of the House
	Insurance Committee this past Monday and will likely pass out of the House next
	Monday. It will then go to the Senate.
5	Rebekah shared that two other bills have passed out of committee: Senator Vogel's
	Telemedicine Bill (SB 739) passed out of the House Insurance Committee and
	Senator Judy Ward's Pharmacy Benefit Manager Bill (SB 1000) passed out of the
	Senate Health & Human Services Committee.
	Rebekah shared a helpful article published by the Penn Capital Star on the Pharmacy
	Benefit Manager issue and SB 1000.
6	Another bill update that may be of interest to the group: HB 2234 (Representative
	Kim) passed out of the House this week. This bill would create a pilot program around
7	a Medicaid wrap-around subsidy. The bill is being led by PHAN. More info here.
