## 3 Discussion

ID	Discussion
1	The group discussed the passage of the FY 24/25 budget. The medical debt proposal was not included but the Medicaid subsidy pilot was. Additionally, the Pharmacy Benefit Manager, Biomarker, and Telemedicine bills that the group has been monitoring have all been signed into law.
2	Donna shared that a staffer from the House Health Committee reached out to her regarding input into the Cancer Control, Prevention, and Research Act, specifically on the Cancer Advisory Board. The group discussed how the Board has not been active for some time. Donna will coordinate with Brenda Anastasio, the PCC Director, on feedback and will copy April Barry and Rebekah Glick.
